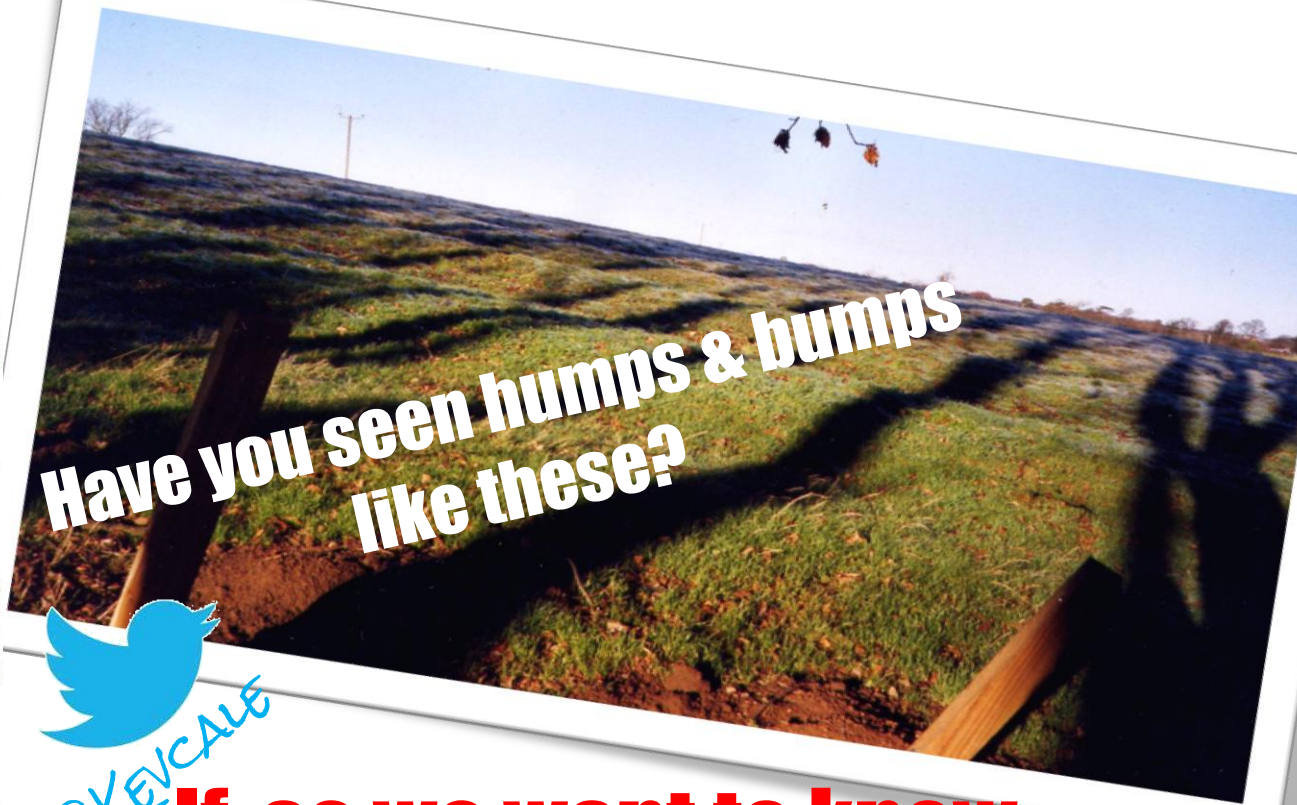

Have you seen humps & bumps like these?



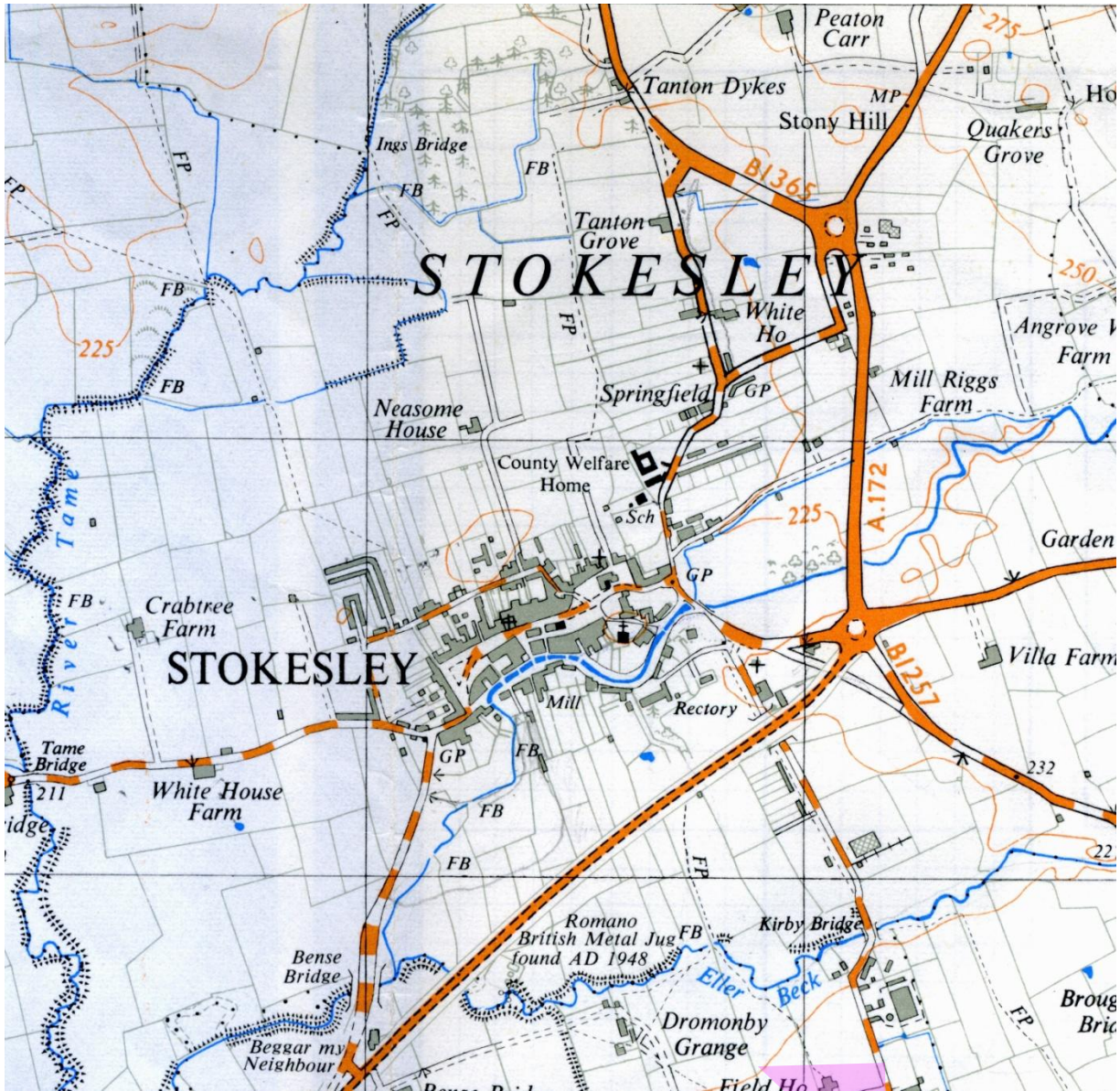
